

REGIONAL DISTRICT OF NORTH OKANAGAN

BY-LAW NO. 1352

A by-law of the Regional District of North Okanagan to establish the local service of solid waste management and disposal.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 788 (1) (c) of the Municipal Act, the Regional District may establish and operate the Local Service of the collection, removal and disposal of waste and noxious, offensive or unwholesome substances;

AND WHEREAS Section 788 (1) (c.1) of the Municipal Act provides that the Regional District may establish and operate the Local Service of the regulation, storage and management of municipal solid waste and recyclable material, including the regulation of facilities and commercial vehicles used in relation to these matters.

AND WHEREAS on December 22nd, 1995 the Regional District of North Okanagan Solid Waste Management Plan was approved pursuant to Section 16 (8) of the Waste Management Act.

AND WHEREAS Section 16 (10) of the Waste Management Act provides that the Waste Management Plan may be implemented without the assent of electors, a petition, an initiative plan or consent on behalf of electors referred to in the Municipal Act.

Local Service Established

1. The local service of collection, removal and disposal of waste and noxious, offensive or unwholesome substances; and the regulation, storage and management of municipal solid waste and recyclable material including the regulation of facilities and commercial vehicles used in relation to these matters is hereby established.

Solid Waste Management

2. The Regional District may on its own or under contract:
 - a) regulate, store and manage Municipal solid waste and recyclable material, including the regulation of facilities and commercial vehicles used in relation to these matters, and
 - b) collect, remove and dispose of waste and noxious and unwholesome substances.

Local Service Area

3. the Service Area for the Local Service established by this bylaw shall encompass and include the City of Armstrong, City of Enderby, City of Vernon, Township of Spallumcheen, District of Coldstream, Village of Lumby and Electoral Areas "B, C, D, E and F."

Levies

4. The costs of providing the service established under Section 1. shall be recovered by:
 - a) the requisition of money under Section 809 and 809.1 of the *Municipal Act* to be collected by a property value tax as provided in Section 810(1) and 810.1(1) of the said Act; on land, on improvements only, or on land and improvements;
 - b) the requisition of money under Section 809 and 809.1 of the *Municipal Act* to be collected by a frontage or parcel tax as provided in Section 810(2) and 810.1(2) of the Said Act;
 - c) the imposition of fees and charges.

Maximum Requisition

5. The Maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually under Section 804(1)(a) and (b) shall not exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00).

Title

6. This Bylaw be cited for all purposes as "Regional District of North Okanagan - Solid Waste Management Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 1352, 1996"




