



INVASIVE PLANT CONTROL CREW MEMBERS AND TEAM LEADER (STUDENT/SEASONAL)

The successful candidates will have a Grade 12 Diploma, enrolled in or graduated from programs related to agriculture, natural resource/environmental studies, sciences (biology and chemistry) or landscaping, and hold a valid Class 5 BC driver's licence without restrictions. Previous experience in applying herbicides or other vegetative management control techniques are considered assets. A willingness to obtain an Industrial Vegetation Management & Noxious Weed Pesticide Applicator Certificate is preferred.

You are physically capable of working in variable outdoor conditions for long hours, are comfortable driving manual transmission vehicles, and operating light equipment. You can respond to the public with tact and courtesy, and have a working knowledge of invasive plant species in the North Okanagan. You work exceptionally well as part of a team, as well as on your own.

Reporting to the Weed Control Officer, the Invasive Plant Control Crew Members are responsible for conducting field inventory, providing treatment for invasive plants, and monitoring areas for invasive plant species presence throughout the North Okanagan.

Team Leader:

In addition to Crew Members duties, the Team Leader will provide leadership for the Invasive Plant Control Crew and liaise with the Weed Control Officer to arrange duties to ensure fairness amongst the team.
