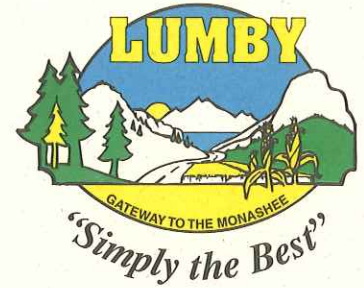

To Whom It May Concern:

Mayor and Council of the Village of Lumby have some concerns we would like to bring up regarding the water system supplying Greater Vernon.

1. We do not understand why Vernon would be adding or would consider adding more users to an already failing/problematic system. The intent to add more users such as Grandview Bench, (allowing Adventure Bay) would be precedent setting.
2. Lumby is not interested in carrying debt for a failed water system in Vernon (Adventure Bay Subdivision). Mayor Sawatsky said there is a lot of water up in the watershed – then why not use it and stop flooding the Village of Lumby, by draining down to the Aberdeen Dam.

What we are asking for and would like to see is:

1. During RDNO policy discussions on funding, that it be the users that assume the risk.
2. RDNO/Vernon/GVAC not be allowed to provide water to any extra residents that it currently does unless it can provide the water without causing hardship to communities below their current watershed.
