An Official Community Plan (OCP) is a document that outlines directions for the future of an area. The plan captures community values and a vision for the future. The OCP can include:

- ◇ identification of lands for residential, commercial, industrial, institutional, recreational, public utility (such as sewers, storm drains, roads, parks and water) and other land uses;
- ◇ policies to protect environmentally sensitive areas and promote environmentally sustainable development; and,
- ◇ economic development policies.

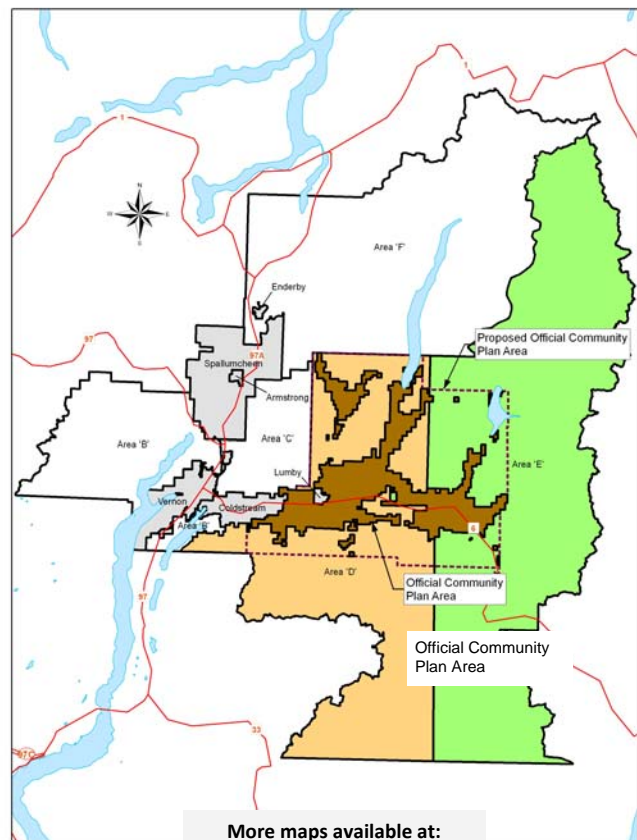
