

DELEGATIONS

Lumby Non-Profits [JEWITT, Gay]

Gay Jewitt provided a presentation requesting that the committee consider amending the current White Valley Parks, Recreation and Culture Fees Imposition Bylaw No.2646 to allow for three hour rentals (rather than only two or four) of the White Valley Community Centre to accommodate tear down and set up time for the White Valley Community Resource Centre and Lumby Health Services Society programs.

NEW BUSINESS

White Valley Parks, Recreation and Culture Fees and Charges Review

Staff informed the committee that they are currently reviewing the dry floor rates of the Pat Duke Arena in the current White Valley Parks, Recreation and Culture Fees Imposition Bylaw No.2646.

Literacy at Play Enhancements to Oval and Hanson Park Playgrounds

That it be recommended to the Board of Directors, up to \$3,000 be approved in the 2016 White Valley Parks, Recreation and Culture budget for playground enhancements that support Literacy at Play objectives, with funds to come from reserves.




