BY-LAW NUMBER 1193

A By-law To Amend The City Of Armstrong
Fire Prevention By-law Number 929, 1986

WHEREAS the City of Armstrong has adopted Fire Prevention By-law Number 929, 1986 and now desires to amend that by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Armstrong in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This By-law may be cited as "The City of Armstrong Fire Prevention Amendment By-law Number 1193, 1994".

2. The following sections are hereby added:

1.3 (c) To provide i) Fire suppression and prevention
ii) Rescue operations
iii) Mutual aid to fire services including Ministry of Forests
iv) Response to hazardous material incidents, and
v) Public services

1.3 (d) The limits of the jurisdiction of the Fire Chief and the Officers and Members of the Fire Department will extend to the area and boundaries of the City of Armstrong and the Corporation of the Township of Spallumcheen, and no part of the fire apparatus shall be used beyond the limits of the jurisdiction without:

(a) the express authorization of a written contract or agreement providing for the supply of fire fighting and assistance response services outside the established boundaries, or

(b) the approval of Council.
