## Paper Products

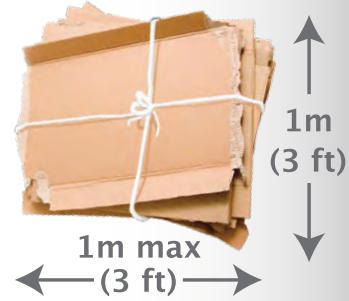


- Books
- Cardboard - flattened, clean & dry
- Catalogues
- Cereal boxes - boxboard
- Envelopes - windows OK
- Magazines & glossy flyers
- Newspaper
- Office paper
- Paper bags
- Paper egg cartons
- Phone books
- Pizza boxes - clean

### How to Recycle:

- Remove plastic liners
- Place all items in blue bag

**Cardboard:**  
Bundle and tie in 1m sections, set at curb (weather permitting)



**NO Glass**



**NO Styrofoam**



**NO Medical Waste**

## Plastics



- Grocery bags
- Milk jugs
- Containers with codes 1-7
- Lids larger than 10cm with codes 1-7
- Packaging with codes 1-7



### How to Recycle:

- Rinse clean
- Flatten milk jugs
- Place all items in blue bag

Use blue or clear bags  
- no bag limit

20 kg (44 lbs) max

## Tin & Aluminum



- Aluminum foil
- Cans, plates, and trays

### How to Recycle:

- Empty and rinse. Labels OK.
- Secure lids inside cans
- Place all items in blue bag
