

# RECYCLING AND DISPOSAL FEES

EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 1, 2012



**All mixed loads entering a RDF will be assessed the highest applicable fee on the entire load. Sorting and separating on site and/or re-scaling to determine actual quantities of each material type is encouraged.**

Medium truck tires without rims	unit	\$10	\$10
Medium truck tires with rims	unit	\$35	\$35
Unsecured load	tonne	\$160	\$10
Chipped yard and garden waste and chipped wood waste	tonne	\$2.50	\$3
Clean wood waste (must be unfinished, no metal hardware except nails and screws)	tonne	\$20	\$3
Dirty wood waste (may be finished, no metal hardware except nails and screws)	tonne	\$20	\$3
Yard and garden waste (pay days)	tonne	\$20	\$3
Yard and garden waste (free days)	tonne	\$0	\$0

For RDFs without scales, the following conversion factors apply when determining the recycling and disposal fee:

REFUSE: 0.4 tonnes/m<sup>3</sup> • WOOD and YARD WASTE: 0.25 tonnes/m<sup>3</sup>

**NOTE:**

- All fees are prorated, minimum charges apply
- Higher disposal fees apply to waste from outside the RDNO
