Greater Vernon Adopt-A-Park Program

The Regional District of North Okanagan encourages residents, community organizations and businesses to become directly involved in improving our city parks and other landscaped areas through an Adopt-A-Park Program.

The Regional District recognizes the contributions of the adopting groups and individuals by making and erecting signs bearing their names and logos, if feasible, in the adopted parks.

The goal of the Adopt-A-Park Program is to have all Greater Vernon park and landscaped public areas adopted by as wide a range of community organizations, neighborhood groups and individuals as possible.

Adopting a park can take many forms, including establishing a presence in the park to be on the lookout for vandalism and maintenance problems and reporting these to the Regional District; providing maintenance assistance in the form of general park clean-up, such as picking up litter, painting, weeding and minor planting (e.g., flowers, replacement shrubbery); providing direct monetary assistance for park enhancements; leading by example as a Dog Ambassador; and providing input to the Regional District on park use.

Regional District staff will assist within available resources to provide training and to supervise the progress of the work of each individual or group who adopt a park or other area.

The purpose of this program is to build community spirit and a sense of civic responsibility. By supplementing Regional District resources, this program will enhance the condition and beauty of our parks and other landscaped areas and will improve the quality of life in Greater Vernon for the entire community.

It is understood that no compensation of any kind will be paid to the participant(s). Participants will be recognized by a sign in the park.
