



1.1 Invitation to Tenderers

1.5 Bonding Requirements

- .1 The tender shall be accompanied by an Undertaking of Surety and a Bid Bond in the sum of at least ten percent (10%) of the amount of tender.
- .2 The Undertaking of Surety shall bind the guaranty (or surety) company to the Tenderer in a “Performance and Fulfillment Bond” and “Labour and Material Payment Bond” each for fifty percent (50%) of the amount of the tender.
