**THE APPLICANT AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING TERMS:**

1. Water use will be charged at the Domestic Consumption Rate per the current Greater Vernon Water Rates Imposition Bylaw.
2. The Operator Service Fee will apply annually for each operator visit to turn on and turn off the irrigation service, per the current Greater Vernon Water Rates Imposition Bylaw.
3. An irrigation meter must be in place before an irrigation service can be turned on.
4. Irrigation Season means the five (5) month period from approximately mid-April to mid-September, as may be modified by drought or other conditions as determined by the RDNO from time to time.
5. To discontinue the annual turn on/off of the irrigation service and associated Operator Service Fee, the customer is required to contact Greater Vernon Water prior to the irrigation service being turned on for the Irrigation Season.

**IMPORTANT:** (Please initial)

Greater Vernon Water (GVW) does not accept responsibility for any damage (freezing, etc.) to the irrigation system, service connection, back flow prevention device, water meter or the Encoder Receiver Transmitter (ERT). Such damage will be repaired at the owner's cost.

Please leave your irrigation meter on until the final meter reading and the service has been turned off for the irrigation season by municipal staff, or contact GVW to complete the final meter reading.
