

## ENCODER-RECEIVER-TRANSMITTER OPT OUT FORM Greater Vernon Water

The Encoder-Receiver-Transmitter (ERT) opt out option is available for Greater Vernon Water (GVW) customers. This option allows customers to request a manual reading of their meter(s) and not have an ERT installed on their property. Those who opt out will be subject to a quarterly fee per the current *Greater Vernon Water Rates Imposition Bylaw*, to have their meter read manually. The current fee can be found on the Regional District of North Okanagan website at www.rdno.ca.
