



The North Okanagan Map is built with HTML5 technology and does **not** require a plug-in download.




How to Change Visible Map Layers

1. By Default not all map layers are visible on initial load of the North Okanagan Map. To view all layers for the maps you can click the 'I want to..' button and select 'change visible map layers', Or you can click the layers button on the lower left of the screen.




2. Scroll and view all the available layers, you can click the + sign to expand the layers.


3. To view imagery, look under the 'Base Maps' layers. Make sure you are zoomed in to your area of interest, these layers are scale dependent. Different years have different areas of interest, try multiple base layers until your area shows imagery.



4. The zoning layer is located under Top Layers > Land Use.




5. If you require legal text for example plan numbers, this layer is found under Cadastral>Legal Text> Your area of interest. This is a scale dependent layer, make sure you are zoomed in at a minimum of 1:5000.




How to Search for an Address

Click the 'I want to...' button.
 If you are located in Vernon, click the 'Find a COV (City of Vernon) address'.
 If you are located outside of Vernon, click the 'Find a RDNO Address'




2. Type in your address, the street name will help autofill the address for you. Once you press search the map will zoom to your area of interest.






3. By clicking on the result this will zoom to and highlight the property, this opens the RDNO parcels details.




How to Run a Report for the Property


1. Select the 4 line icon next to RDNO Parcels on the left hand side of screen. Select 'Run a Report'.



2. The 'choose report' window opens, select the blue 'RDNO property info'.



3. A message appears about generating a report, when read it will display report ready, select the 'Download report file' to open the report. This will open in a new window where you can print your report.




How to Print a Map


1. To access tools for printing, double click the North Okanagan Map title banner, or click the tools button on the upper right corner of the website.



2. Next click the tools tab on the upper banner, then the print button.



3. There are 5 options on how you could like the map to be formatted. When ready select the print button.



4. A message stating 'Preparing file, Please wait...' will show up. When the print map windows opens, your file is ready. To view the file, please click the 'Open File' button. This will open a new window where you can download or print you new map.
