MATERIALS ACCEPTED AND FEE SCHEDULE

Bagged residential and commercial garbage is accepted for the following fees:

| Year | 2023 | 2024 |
|------------------------|-------------|-------------|
| Minimum Fee | \$8.00 | \$10.00 |
| Prorated Fee per Tonne | \$110.00 | \$113.00 |

- The minimum fee covers loads up to 72 kilograms (approximately 158 lbs) in 2023 and up to 88 kilograms (194 lbs) in 2024.
- Flattened cardboard and boxboard is accepted for recycling at no charge.
- Payment is accepted by Cash, Debit, Mastercard, Visa or Prepaid Card.
- Recycling and composting bins onsite are provided and managed by Destination Silver Star (250-275-4942). The DSS recycling bins accept household paper and packaging (metal, paper & rigid plastic).

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED

The following materials are not accepted at Silver Star Transfer Station:

- Animal Remains
- Batteries
- Construction and Demolition Materials
- Electronics
- Furniture
- Propane Tanks
- Hazardous/ Flammable Items
- Large Appliances
- Scrap Metal
- Tires
- Yard and Garden Waste
- Wood Waste

There are provincial recycling programs for a wide range of products including: batteries, electronics, lightbulbs, medications, motor oil and antifreeze, packaging and paper, paint, tires and more.

There are also a number of donation and thrift store options nearby that accept quality household items and sometimes furniture for reuse.
