**911 Emergency Telephone Referendum By-law No. 761**

The question was asked: "Are you in favour of the Regional District of North Okanagan acquiring the function of and installing and operating the 911 Emergency Telephone number, and are you prepared to participate in the cost of this service with all its member municipalities and Electoral Areas on the basis of costs apportioned and levied upon the land and improvement assessment for Regional Hospital District purposes, commencing in the year when the equipment is installed and to authorize the borrowing of an amount not to exceed \$600,000 for this purpose?"

The 911 Emergency Telephone Referendum By-law No. 761 question was passed with 8,788 ballots cast in favour of the question and 3,598 ballots cast against the question. Percentage of vote in favour of the question was 70.95%; percentage of vote against question was 29.05%. Percentage voter turnout was 37.10%.
