<b>Please Note:</b>	<p>In advance of an emergency that triggers an Evacuation Order, the RDNO acknowledges the signatory of this form wishes to remain on their property during an emergency event. Please note that access to and from your property cannot be guaranteed, and therefore, you will need to ensure you have prepared your property and obtained adequate supplies in advance of an event accordingly.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>The signatory confirms acceptance that they wish to remain in or enter an area deemed to be an “area of extreme danger to life and safety”. And that emergency response people may not be available for rescue or assistance.</b></li> <li>• <b>The signatory is of the age of majority for BC (19 yrs.), acknowledges the <i>declared state of emergency</i> giving rise to the evacuation order for the specified location, is the owner/tenant of the premises and not an employee of the farm, as defined by the Workers Compensation Act and Regulation BC.</b></li> <li>• <b>The signatory will monitor the current state of the emergency to assure their safety, checking the media and other communication means for officially released and substantiated updates.</b></li> </ul> <p>Roadblocks into an Evacuation Order Area may be in place, and the timing for gaining access and egress from the Order Area will be dependent upon the emergency. By completing this form, your name will be on a registry, and if logistically possible, you will be able to access your property. Your reason to remain on your property is to maintain essential services, e.g., animal health and well-being; it may not be possible to ensure business continuity, as emergency operations may change for life safety reasons until the order has been lifted.</p>

In consideration for being permitted to remain in or enter the evacuation area, I hereby release and forever discharge the Regional District of North Okanagan and other responding agencies and their officers, agents, employees, contractors and volunteers (collectively, the “Released Parties”) and agree to indemnify and save harmless the Released Parties from and against all losses, claims, damages, actions, causes of action, costs and expenses whatsoever, that the Released Parties may sustain, incur, suffer or be put to, including those arising from the negligence of the Released Parties, by reason of this permit or my entering into the Evacuation Area.”</i></p>
