What Is It?

A Community Wildfire Resiliency Plan (CWRP) is a strategic, community-driven initiative designed to minimise the risk and impact of wildfires. This plan identifies wildfire hazards and outlines actions to enhance safety and preparedness.

It serves as a roadmap for reducing wildfire threats while aligning local priorities with provincial objectives.

- Identifies vulnerable areas in the community,
- Outlines actions to reduce risk and protect homes/infrastructure,
- Builds awareness and resiliency.

Who develops the plan?

The RDNO values residents' input. Through various engagements, we gather information about local challenges, ways to enhance community safety, and the issues that matter most in your neighborhood. This information is then compiled into a plan tailored to your community.

The RDNO has partnered with **Forsite Consultants Ltd.** to analyse the data and develop the plan.

Who pays for the plan?

Funds from the BC Government are provided to the Union of BC Municipalities (UBCM), which administers the Community Resiliency Investment Program (CRI) that finances this CWRP project.
