

# REGIONAL DISTRICT OF NORTH OKANAGAN

## BYLAW No. 3052

A bylaw to establish fees for the use of public electric vehicle charging stations

---

**WHEREAS** Section 378 [*Options for cost recovery*] of the *Local Government Act*, provides that a regional district may recover the costs of its services by fees and charges imposed under Section 397 [*Imposition of fees and charges*];

**AND WHEREAS** Section 397 [*Imposition of fees and charges*] of the *Local Government Act* provides that a Board may, by bylaw, impose a fee or charge payable in respect of the use of regional district property;

**AND WHEREAS** the Board is desirous to authorize and impose the fees and charges payable for the use of Regional District of North Okanagan operated public electric vehicle charging infrastructure;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Board of the Regional District of North Okanagan in an open meeting assembled, hereby **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

### CITATION

1. This Bylaw may be cited as “***Electric Vehicle Charging Fees Bylaw No. 3052, 2025***”.

### DEFINITIONS

2. In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:

“**Electric Vehicle**” means a vehicle that uses electricity for propulsion and that can use an external source of electricity to charge the vehicle’s batteries.

“**Electric Vehicle Charging Station**” means an Electric Vehicle charging station operated by the Regional District of North Okanagan and available for use by members of the public.

### FEES

3. A person in charge, control, or possession of any Electric Vehicle who connects an Electric Vehicle to an Electric Vehicle Charging Station shall pay a fee of \$1.20 per hour plus applicable taxes.

### EXEMPTIONS

4. Fees provided under Section 3 do not apply to Regional District of North Okanagan fleet vehicles.


5. This Bylaw will take effect on December 1, 2025.
