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Expanded Evacuation Alert Issued for Bradley Creek FSR / Six Mile Creek Wildfire

Based upon recommendation from the BC Wildfire Service, an Expanded Evacuation Alert has been issued by Regional District North Okanagan (RDNO) at the Emergency Operations Centre due to a wildfire at Bradley Creek FSR / Six Mile Creek (#K41351).

Because of the potential danger to life and health, the RDNO has issued an **Expanded Evacuation Alert** for the following areas located in Electoral Area "B":

17 and 65 Cain Road

131, 252, 351, 425, 485, 631, 635 Nashwito Road

10, 15, 50, 93 Banks Road

79, 305, 311, 315, 464 Beau Park Road

The following properties continue to remain on **Evacuation Alert**:

278, 221, 236, 267 Siwash Creek Road

59 Beatrice Road

442, 503, 545, 550, 560, 651, 655, 659, 661, 730, 735, 809, 878, 890, 901, 930,
1001, 1070, 1075, 1135, 1195, 1470 Six Mile Creek Road

The following properties remain on **Evacuation Order**:

West side of Irish Creek Road: 257, 280, 300, 304, 306, 396, 398, 424, 570, 576, 590,
610, 614, 620, 640, 644, 664, 668, 678 Irish Creek Road

The Evacuation Alert has been expanded due to concerns regarding available egress routes as two active wildfires continue to impact the Westside Road area. Expanding the alert provides residents with additional time to prepare should evacuation become necessary. Maintaining safe evacuation options remains a priority, and emergency crews are actively working to protect transportation corridors and keep evacuation routes open, clear, and accessible for residents and emergency responders.

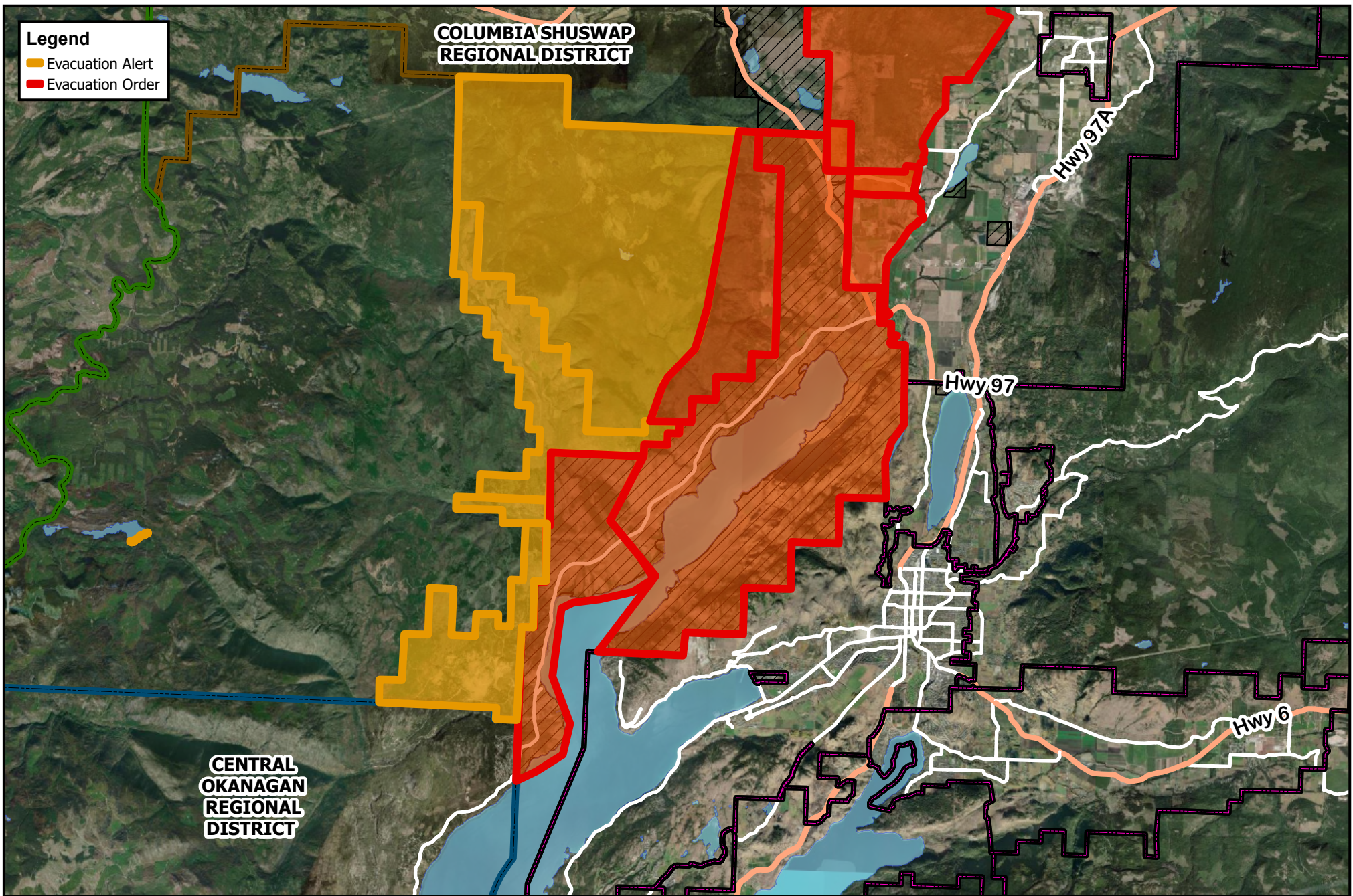
An Evacuation Alert has been issued to prepare you to evacuate your premises or property within the mapped area should it be found necessary. Residents will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to evacuation; however you may receive limited notice due to changing conditions. *See map of Evacuation Alert area attached.*

Please note: The attached map is a general guideline. Any property in close proximity to the area should be prepared, and ready to evacuate during threatened times.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Locate family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.
- Pack essential items such as government issued ID, medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers, immediate care needs for dependents and, if time and space permits, keepsakes for quick departure.
- Prepare to move persons with disabilities, children or neighbours, if assistance is needed.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- Arrange transportation for all household members. Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating.
- Monitor the news, radio and online sources for information on evacuation orders and location of Reception Centres.
